Scholarships for law students to perform externships:

- There was some discussion about utilizing law students to work in attorney offices in various counties where Veteran Service Organizations and other organizations have shown a desire to contribute to legal services for their local residents. This would provide an opportunity for students to perform externships (receive school credit), but also receive a contribution for providing those services.
 - The Section would not handle the money. The organizations would provide it to the student or supervising attorney
 - We need to review what the three law school externship requirements are and whether this is something viable
 - Important to note, ensure that it is set up so there is accountability for the money (stipend) to the student. We want students to be able to return to those organizations and show what those contribution provided; i.e. what services were provided. Eliminate a student from receiving money and doing nothing with it.
